



Traffic Control Course



For people wishing to control traffic on public roads, this is the course for you. Implement a traffic management plan while ensuring traffic flow is maintained and the safety of the public and workers is minimised. These units include traffic management plans for not only public, but private roads as well as parking areas, and restricted access construction sites.

This is ideal knowledge and skills for the protection of construction sites, workers and the general public. Even animal welfare activists who need to operate on roads have completed this course.

After the course you are required to complete 40 hours of supervised work experience, to obtain a full qualification (Traffic Control Ticket). iAscend may assist you in obtaining a work experience placement. Speak to our instructors and they will advise you and assist you with the necessary paperwork.

Photo ID is required: You will be required to present photo ID on the day of training. (Check website for acceptable forms of ID required.)
